

CITY OF LINDSTROM OPENING - CITY COUNCIL MEMBER

The City of Lindstrom has an opening on the City Council.

A candidate for Lindstrom City Council must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Must be 21 years of age or more upon assuming office;
- Be eligible to vote in Minnesota (not required to be a registered voter, but must meet those requirements);
- An individual who has been convicted of a felony under either state or federal law cannot hold elective office in Minnesota unless the individual's civil rights have been restored;
- Must have not filed for another office at the upcoming primary or general election;
- May not currently hold an office that would be incompatible with performing the duties of a councilmember;
- May not have an impermissible conflict of interest; and
- Must have maintained residence in their district for at least 30 days before the general election. (Note: To remain a councilmember, the individual must continue to maintain residency in their district in the City of Lindstrom.)

This is a temporary appointment through December 31, 2020.
