**DECLARATION DETERMINING MEETINGS BY TELEPHONE OR
OTHER ELECTRONIC MEANS**

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Minnesota has declared a health pandemic emergency and the City of Lindstrom has declared a location emergency in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Chapter 12; and

WHEREAS, per Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, the Mayor and City Administrator may determine that an in-person meeting is not practical or prudent due to a pandemic or emergency.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and City Administrator of the City of Lindstrom, Minnesota, determines as follows:

In-person meetings during this pandemic are not practical nor prudent. As such, all meetings of the City Council, other City governed boards, and commissions, including the Planning Commission, shall be held in accordance with Minn. Stat. § 13D.021 which permits meetings by telephone or other electronic means until further notice.

Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 2 allows all members participating by telephone or other electronic means to be considered present for purposes of quorum.

Additionally, no members of the public affected by this determination may be at the regular meeting location for the meetings. Minn. Stat. § 13D.021 subd. 3 allows for public monitoring of these meetings. More details will be available on monitoring meetings through public notice.
